- The seminar will be held at the Undercover Dog Ring, Castle Hill Showground, Showground Road, Castle Hill.
- The seminar will be conducted on mats.
- Seminar Times:
  - Friday 17 April – Commences 12:30pm to approximately 4:00pm.
  - Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 April – Commences 9:00am to approximately 4:00pm.
  - Monday 20 April – Commences 9:00am. Individual session times will be finalised after closing date.
- All participants are expected to arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the start time to check in, ensuring working dogs and participants are set up and ready to start at 9:00am.
- Morning and afternoon tea will be provided and will consist of tea, coffee and biscuits
- There will be a one hour lunch break on Saturday and Sunday. Please bring your own lunch, drinks and other snacks that you require.
- Please bring your own chair. If this is not possible, please let us know and we will try to arrange one for you.
- Please bring plenty of training treats and your dog's favourite toys. We will not be providing any training treats.

#### Terms and Conditions of Booking

1. All attendees must be AFA members for insurance purposes. Dogs must have a valid Competition Racing Number (CRN).
2. 30% Deposit is due by Friday 31 January 2020. Final balance is due Friday 06 March 2020. Please pay via bank transfer to the following account:

This request will be final and will not give rise to any financial compensation or claim.
8. The working of dogs that are injured or appears to be injured (unless certified by a vet) is strictly prohibited. We reserve the right to halt the training of a dog that is deemed unsound either at the beginning of or during the seminar and will not give rise to any financial compensation or claim. The handler will be given the option to work a loan dog in its place if available.
